Virtual adventures await!



The renovated Narva Town Hall building hides something completely unprecedented – Estonia's first augmented and virtual reality exhibition!

This exciting attraction uses virtual reality glasses and touchscreens to revive the city of Narva as it was before World War II. If you are looking for adventure, this is the place to go to in Narva!

WHY COME?

- Have you ever wanted to travel through time?
- Would you like to see this former European Baroque pearl, which is now preserved only in memories and old photographs, with your own eyes?
- Would you like to get an idea of how much influence the bombing of Narva had and how Narva has changed over time?
- Would you like to hear exciting stories about amazing people whose fate was closely connected to Narva and who are still being talked about?

At the virtual exhibition you can:

- travel around pre-war city of Narva with the help of VR glasses,
- use tablets to view 3D models of the most exciting buildings of the old town,
- get acquainted with the pre-war life of the city,
- hear stories and experience history through the eyes of the inhabitants of the time.
- explore the borders of Old Narva.

The duration of one session is about 40 minutes. Groups (from 10 people) can book a time-travelling trip at their convenience.



OPENING HOURS

There is more to explore in the vicinity of the Town Hall. Also visit:

- the model of Old Narva at the Art Gallery of Narva Museum,
- Casemates of Victoria Bastion,
- Narva castle,
- the soon-to-open theme park in Sillamäe,
- virtual time travel in Toila, 'VR Toila 1938'.

Joint ticket! Groups (from 10 people) can also book a joint virtual tour of Old Narva, the Old Town tour, and the Victoria Bastion tour. Tours are conducted in Estonian, Russian, and English.
